***RULES – REGULATIONS & FEES***

Due to the increased use of the transfer station for the disposal of demolition debris, wood scraps and bulk house hold items, it has become necessary to establish the following new additional rate schedule.

- One barrel of such materials = \$10.00
- 1 Yard (approx. ½ pickup or ½ utility trailer) = \$20.00
- 2 yards (approx.. 1 pickup or 1 utility trailer) = \$40.00
- Household appliances containing Freon = \$15.00

Please separate all other items brought to the transfer station.

- a. Household trash placed into the compactor – **BAGS MUST BE CLEAR**
- b. All recyclable glass, plastic and tin to be placed in the **RECYCLING** container
- c. Scrap metal is accepted at no charge and should be placed in the **METAL** container
- d. All recycle paper products must be broken down, flat and placed in the **PAPER** container
- e. Oil and Anti-Freeze (up to 5 gallons per visit) are accepted at no charge
- f. **NO PAINT OR OTHER HAZARDOUS WASTE IS ACCEPTED**
- g. Batteries are accepted for a fee as long as they are sealed with tape
- h. Electronics are accepted for a fee and go into the **ELECTRONICS SHED – SEE ATTENDANT**
- i. Fluorescent bulbs are accepted for a fee
- j. Refrigerators are accepted for a fee and **must** have their doors removed to be accepted.
- k. BIO Hazards sharps containers are available on site **MUST SEE ATTENDANT FOR INSTRUCTIONS**
- l. **ABSOLUTLEY NO YARD WASTE WILL BE ACCEPTED**
- m. When disposing of lawn furniture, please remove any textiles and plastic from the metal frames. When separated please place in the appropriate containers.
