Open Meeting:

7:06 p.m. Mr. Dolby called meeting to order, provided notice that meeting will be recorded.

New Business:

1. Angeline Ellison – Town Administrator Interview
 - a. The Board reviewed Mrs. Ellison’s resume and asked her questions from a list compiled by all three members. See attached.
2. Chapter 90 Phase 1 Bid Results:
 - a. No bids received, Mr. Curry spoke with AG’s office and have to put it back into the central registry.
 - b. Discussed putting phases together into one bid. Mr. Montanaro will follow-up.

4. ID Policy: reviewed and revised. Mr. Dolby motion to implement the ID policy as amended, Mr. Levakis second, unanimous vote.

5. Community Compact Meeting: meeting tomorrow at 3:30, Mr. Dolby confirmed with legal that Linda Smith and Tony van Werkhoven can attend and take part in the community compact meetings. If more than one is going to attend they will need to post it as a finance committee meeting.
6. North Blandford Road Complaints: resident on North Blandford Road complaining about large trucks carrying granite, about 4 trucks per hour. The Board asked Cara to draft a letter to the owner of the granite quarry on North Blandford Road to attend the next Selectboard meeting.
 - a. Mr. Levakis will follow-up with DOT regarding the weight limit on the bridge.
