

TOWN OF BLANDFORD Water Department, Minutes May 5, 2016

Attendance: Gordon Avery, William Levakis, Brad Curry, Cara Letendre - Secretary

Open Meeting:

4:10 p.m. Mr. Levakis formally called meeting to order, provided notice that meeting will be recorded.

New Business:

- 1. Doug Emo: asked Board to change his billing to one service as he no longer has an apartment at this residence.
 - **a.** Mr. Avery motion to convert 108 Main Street to 1 service effective the 4th quarter billing cycle of FY16, Mr. Levakis second, unanimous vote.
- 2. Abatement: Mr. Levaksi motion to grant an abatement to Blanchette at 10 Maple Lane Road for \$69.17, water usage for 5 months, as applied, Mr. Avery second, unanimous vote
- **3.** Minutes: Mr. Avery motion to approve minutes of April 6, 2016 as written, Mr. Levakis second, unanimous vote.
- **4.** FY17 Salary for Plant Operator:
 - **a.** Mr. Avery we calculated the amount based on \$25.63 per hour for 5 hours a day at 5 days per week. This will equal \$33,319.00 per year leaving \$3,681.00 to pay out for sampling, biologicals, back flows, etc.
 - **b.** Back-up Plant Operator: we calculated \$19.48 per hour for 5 hours per/day 2 days per/week. Once Norene has completed her T2 course and test she will be an operator and she can cover for Bernie when he does sampling, etc.
 - **c.** The plant requires 4 hours a day to run efficiently so this will incorporate overtime.
- **5.** Refinance Loans: Mr. Avery spoke with Treasurer, we will have to wait until the audit is complete to move forward with refinancing as we can't borrow money until it is complete.
 - **a.** Treasurer checked with Rural Development and we will get a better rate if we wait until an audit is complete.
 - **b.** Len Shuzdac from Rural Water is looking into when we have to have the meters up and running per our loan contract.
 - **i.** Mr. Levakis has been in contact with DEP to let them know we are working on it.
- **6.** Water Plant Operator: Mr. Avery met with Mr. St. Martin last week. Will wait to have discussion until he is present.

- **a.** Mr. St. Martin is concerned that the chemical feed lines are getting old. Tabled until Mr. St. Martin is present to discuss.
- **b.** Commissioners will plan to meet at the plant for the next meeting.

Old Business:

- 1. Filters: working better in warmer weather, still underlying issues.
 - **a.** Cara will check budget to see if funding is available to bring Bob Lecraw in from MS Filters. Quote is \$2,180.00.
- **2.** Glasgow Road: Mr. Levakis spoke with Jeremy from EJ Prescott and Commissioners will walk Glasgow Road with him on Monday at 4:00 to review project and put together a price list and bid package.
 - **a.** Discussed whether or not the Water Department is obligated to hook the residents back up to the water line once it is replaced. Cara will check with town counsel.
- 3. GPS: Mr. Curry and Mr. Avery will set-up a time to meet up.
