- 1. Consortium Update (10 min)
 - 1. The original State incentive grant for FY18 was \$58,000
 - 1. It was cut to \$29,100 in February
 - 1. The Grant was sent to Russell COA who passed the information to Russell Select Board
 - 2. The Russell BOS signed on the lowered amt. before discussing it with the Consortium
 - 2. Historically each town paid \$250/year dues to the Consortium
 - 3. Consortium paid out of the dues \$50/month to Russell for internet
 - 2. Consortium requesting each town donate \$1000 until State Grants written
 - 1. This would pay for the Store Front Office in Chester
