Municipal Schedule for 2020

February 12 – Last day to register to vote in Presidential Primary (March 3) 2-4 and 7-8 P.M.

**February 21** - Departmental reports due to Town Clerk to be included in the Annual Town Report. If there is no report it will be noted "no report submitted" in the town report.

Monday, February 24, 2019 – Post for Caucus

March 2 - Caucus - first Monday in March, per bylaw: nominee sign papers if present

March 3 – Presidential Primary 7 A.M.-8 P.M.

March 5, 5 p.m. - Last day to accept caucus nomination (within 72 hours of caucus): *Nominee must sign caucus nomination paper* 

March 9, 5 p.m. - Monday, last day to withdraw or to file an objection to nominations made at caucus

March 11, 5 p.m. - Last day to fill any vacancy by a withdrawal or objection:

March 21, 5 p.m. - Saturday, last day to file nomination papers prior to election, with required 20 signatures

March 23 – Monday, WARRANT for ATM Closes on and sent to town counsel for review; this includes the completed budget for ALL TOWN DEPARTMENTS from FinCom

**April 7, 5 p.m.** - Last day to withdraw nomination papers or object to candidate nomination papers for town election filed with required signatures

April 13 – Monday, Post for Informational Meeting (aka Mini Town Meeting) to include on the agenda the completed and reviewed warrant; should be posted Friday. This is a FinCom meeting, their post (April 20 is a holiday)

April 14, Tuesday; 2-4 and 7-8 p.m. - Last day to register to vote at ATM and Annual Town Election

April 21 – Tuesday, Informational Meeting (FinCom) (aka: Mini town meeting) – per bylaw

April 27 – Post for town meeting and election, ONE WARRANT

May 4 - Annual Town Meeting –7 p.m. - per bylaw

*NB At least a half-hour prior to ATM Town Administrator, Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen and Town Counsel meet to review warrant and prepare for any potential controversial items.* 

May 9 – Saturday, Annual Town Election; 10 a.m. – 4 p.m. per bylaw
