

**Town of Blandford
Conservation Commission Minutes
June 13, 2022 6:00 PM**

Commission Members in attendance: Dick Gates, Colleen Doyle, John Piper, and Nate Maynard.

Others in Attendance: Dave Waldron (Hwy Superintendent), Mark Cerilli (resident)

I. New Business

a. Questions about Bradley Brook Conservation Area: Mark Cerilli

M Cerilli was looking for additional information regarding the location and access to the Bradley Brook Conservation Area in town. D Gates was able to track down the deed info for the land and it was determined that the location on Google Maps was inaccurate. The parcel is a relatively new CR and will be further investigated and explored by ConCom for passive recreational access.

II. Continuing Business

a. Gibbs Rd. Mitigation Project: Culvert Replacement

D Waldron still has not received any updates from either DEP or Kurt Mayland regarding the culvert project on Gibbs Rd. (mitigation project from PASS Solar due to WPA violations). Waldron is concerned that the culvert will fail if not replaced in a timely manner and may need to take executive action. He will provide a deadline for replacement with the understanding that other mitigative projects may need to be explored if this isn't completed.

b. Review status of the Belle Fleur site (Mass DEP File # 111-059)

Follow-up inspection occurred on 6/9 to review corrective actions to the Enforcement Order that was issued on 5/16. A large number of erosion controls were still not in place. D Gates spoke with D Cardarelli and suggested that he have M Lavoisier (Foresight LLC) walk the property and identify what needs to happen for corrective actions.

The Enforcement Order that was issued on 5/16 was sent by certified mail to Belle Fleur's PO Box in Blandford per D Cardarelli's instruction; and ConCom still has not received a signed receipt that it was received. If corrective measures are not made within the next two weeks, ConCom will be reaching out to DEP for additional support. The Commission would like to maintain oversight of the project but are concerned about Belle Fleur's record of compliance with the OOC and the potential for significant sediment runoff if issues aren't addressed in a timely manner.
