### 3) <u>DEPARTMENT REPORTS</u>

- a) Highway Superintendent Dave Waldron
  - -Beech Hill Road Closure: Granville is closing Beech Hill August 7 on the Granville side and should be closed for about one month. The bridges are being worked on.
  - -South Street and Cobble Mountain Culverts: Working on culverts on both streets. Conservation is working on the Cobble Mountain culvert.
  - -<u>Huntington Road Paving</u>: Highway is working on paving Huntington Road down the hill to the Transfer Station.
  - -Old Chester Road: Waldron reported that Old Chester Road is open again for the season.
  - -<u>Watson Park Road</u>: Allen asked if there is anything that can be done with Watson Park Road as there is a good-sized hole at the back end of the park. Allen is requesting that stone dust be used. Waldron will take care of this.
